(藉由聽收音機,湯姆的英文進步不少。)

## 三、without + N/Ving 沒有~;不~

例句⇒ He now can speak fluent English without making mistakes.

(他現在能講流利的英文,而不犯任何錯誤。)

# 四、On + Ving, $S + V \sim = As soon as \sim - \sim$ ,就~

例句➡ On hearing the news, he fainted.

= As soon as he heard the news, he fainted.

(一聽到消息,他就昏倒了。)

- ⇒ She cried on seeing the rat.
  - = She cried at the sight of the rat.
  - $= She cried \left\{ \begin{array}{l} as soon \ as \\ the \ moment \\ the \ minute \end{array} \right\} she saw the rat.$
